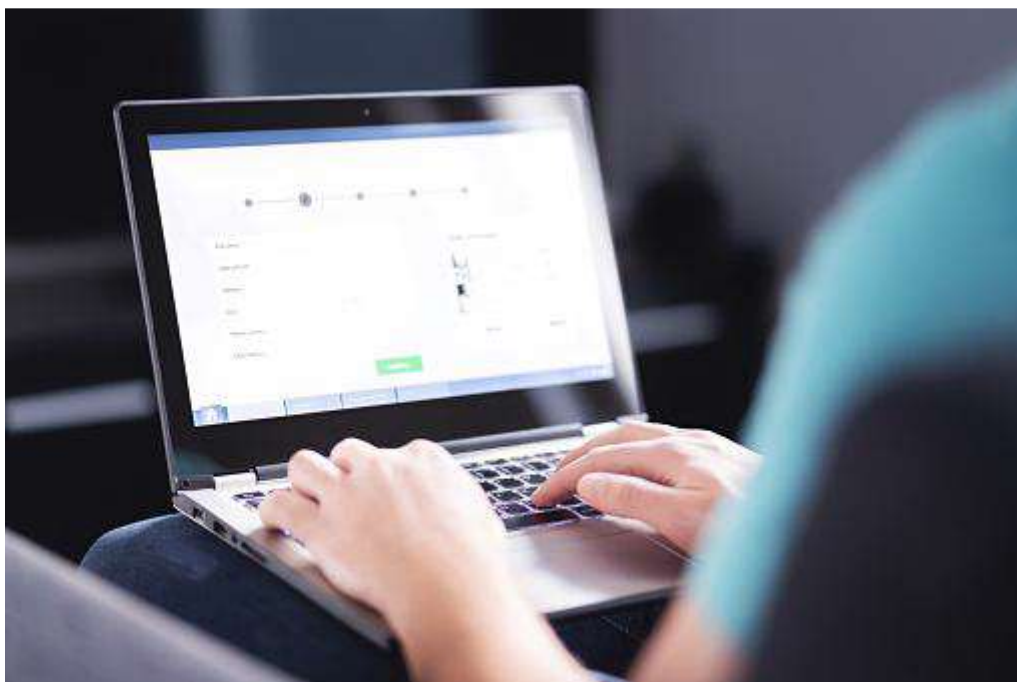

### *Fieldwork Update*



The GGS in Norway is the first GGS that was conducted fully online (CAWI). The fieldwork started on 23 November 2020 and was completed about a month later on 22 December 2020. The survey was conducted by Statistics Norway. More than 4500 questionnaires were completed and are currently being checked. In the Czech Republic the fieldwork is currently in progress.

Denmark and Hong Kong will soon start their data collection. Estonia is preparing for the start of their fieldwork.

### ***Consortium Board Meeting***



From 14 to 16 December the Consortium Board (CB) convened online to discuss current developments and plans for the next year. The CB consists of institutions that pledge their resources and know-how to the development, coordination and promotion of the GGP. The board members meet every year to discuss progress, experiences and plans for future programme development.

### ***Internship in the GGP team***

In 2020, the GGP initiated a new round of fieldwork. The major mode of data collection in the majority of participating countries is currently a web survey developed and processed in Blaise 5, our Computer-Assisted Interviewing system and survey processing tool. Apart from substantive data, extensive device-type and questionnaire navigation paradata is available.



We are now looking for a master or PhD student who will analyse the paradata collected so far. We are interested in insights based on higher levels of aggregation of paradata (across respondents and/or variables). In particular, we are seeking information concerning: browser used to take the survey, the device type and its operating system; changes in answers; number of error messages/prompts/data validation messages; response latency; break-offs.
